
A Postcard from All-of-the-Above American Energy to President Obama in Seoul, South Korea

Background

1. The <u>Energy Information Administration</u> reports that:

"With limited domestic energy resources, South Korea is almost entirely dependent on imports to meet its energy consumption needs."

2. On November 11th, the White House announced that President Obama would hold a **Forum on Jobs and Economic Growth** on December 3rd.

However, the <u>Associated Press</u> reported today that:

"President Barack Obama says <u>creating jobs isn't the goal of a coming White</u> <u>House forum on jobs</u> and economic growth."

President Obama told **NBC News** that he is holding this forum:

"To find out what exactly is going on."

3. In June 2009, House Republicans introduced the <u>American Energy Act (H.R. 2846)</u> - an all-of-the-above energy plan that will responsibly use our natural resources to create new energy and new jobs.
