**Subject:** Legislative Hearing – April 25, 2013

On **Thursday, April 25, 2013 at 1:00 p.m. in 1334 Longworth House Office Building**, the Subcommittee on Fisheries, Wildlife, Oceans and Insular Affairs will hold a legislative hearing on the following bills:

- **H.R. 573** (Sablan), To amend Public Law 93-435 with respect to the Northern Mariana Islands, providing parity with Guam, the Virgin Islands, and American Samoa.
- **H.R. 638** (Fleming), To amend the National Wildlife Refuge System Administration Act of 1966 to require that any new national wildlife refuge may not be established except as expressly authorized by statute. *“National Wildlife Refuge Review Act of 2013.”*
- **H.R. 1300** (Runyan), To amend the Fish and Wildlife Act of 1956 to reauthorize the volunteer programs and community partnerships for the benefit of national wildlife refuges, and for other purposes.
- **H. R. 1384** (Sablan), To provide for the issuance of a Wildlife Refuge System Conservation Semipostal Stamp. *“Wildlife Refuge System Conservation Semipostal Stamp Act of 2013.”*
