

COMMITTEE MARKUP ACTION SUMMARY REPORT

The Committee on Natural Resources met in open session on May 8, 2014, to consider the following bills:

H.R. 3687 (Issa), To amend the National Historic Preservation Act to provide that if the head of the agency managing Federal property objects to the inclusion of certain property on the National Register or its designation as a National Historic Landmark for reasons of national security, the Federal property shall be neither included nor designated until the objection is withdrawn, and for other purposes. *“Military Land and National Defense Act”*

The Subcommittee on Public Lands and Environmental Regulation was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3687 by unanimous consent.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 20 yeas and 12 nays.

H.R. 4458 (McCarthy), To make permanent the withdrawal and reservation of public land previously withdrawn and reserved to support the operations of Naval Air Weapons Station China Lake, California, and to provide for the withdrawal and reservation of additional public land. *“Naval Air Weapons Station China Lake Security Enhancement Act”*

The Subcommittee on Public Lands and Environmental Regulation was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4458 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Bishop of Utah Amendment #1, was AGREED TO by voice vote.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives, as amended, by a roll call vote of 24 yeas and 13 nays.
