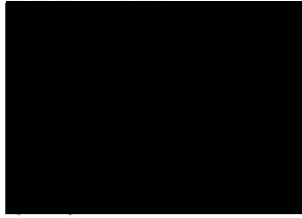

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

Richard began his duties as Vice President of Lands at Arctic Slope Regional Corp. on February 5, 2001. Prior to that date, Richard headed the North Slope Borough Department of Energy Management for six years, where he supervised village energy development for the eight villages of the North Slope Borough. A certified professional geologist in the state of Alaska, Richard has experience in many aspects of North Slope geology, including natural gas exploration and development, geological mapping, and permafrost and sea ice research.

Richard holds positions on many boards and commissions; most of them dedicated to education and research. In addition to other postings, he was twice appointed by President Clinton to the United States Arctic Research Commission, is the Board President of the Barrow Arctic Science Consortium, and was the Chairman of the Board of Trustees for Ilisagvik College, located in Barrow, Alaska.

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

Executive Vice-President, Lands, Arctic Slope Regional Corporation (2001-present)
– Maximize the economic value of the lands received by the Corporation as part of the Settlement Act (ANCSA) to enhance Inupiat cultural land economic freedoms. Since 2002, Richard has also held an At-Large Seat on ASRC’s board of directors.

Provide current and long-range planning that complements ongoing and future energy programs.

General Manager, Barrow Technical Services (BTS) (1993-1995) - Manage small technical firm providing consulting project management, geologic, and scientific research support services. Projects included: North Slope Energy Alternatives Study, Barrow Gas Field geology and reservoir engineering studies, comprehensive housing plans, solid waste management plans, technical support for a proposed US Department of Energy climate research facility, technical and logistical support for many ice research organizations, including US Navy, Army Corps of Engineers, and many universities and colleges.

Geologist, Arctic Slope Consulting Group (1985-1993) - Employment was part-time and on a per project basis until 1991 - Projects included: Barrow gas field and Walakpa (Ualiqpaa) field seismic exploration and drilling development programs, research and wellsite geology. Manager and principal investigator of a US Department of Energy grant to study the methane hydrate potential of the Walakpa natural gas field, Brooks Range mineral exploration, Western Arctic coal Development Program, ice road construction management, and sea ice research and operations technical support.
