

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3650**  
**OFFERED BY MR. YOUNG OF ALASKA**

In section 1(a) (page 1, line 5), strike “2015” and insert “2016”.

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 7. CONDITIONS ON CHANGES TO LAND MANAGEMENT**  
2 **PLANS REGARDING MANAGEMENT OF**  
3 **YOUNG-GROWTH STANDS.**

4 (a) CHANGES CONDITIONED ON COMPREHENSIVE IN-  
5 VENTORY OF THE YOUNG-GROWTH STANDS.—Before any  
6 change to an applicable land management plan takes ef-  
7 fect that will alter management of young-growth stands  
8 covered by the land management plan, the Secretary  
9 shall—

10 (1) conduct a comprehensive inventory of the  
11 young-growth stands;

12 (2) provide public notice of the availability of  
13 the comprehensive inventory; and

14 (3) after such public notice, provide a period of  
15 not less than 90 days for public comment on the  
16 comprehensive inventory.

1 (b) INVENTORY REQUIREMENTS.—At a minimum,  
2 the comprehensive inventory required by subsection (a)  
3 shall—

4 (1) include stand-level field work with respect to  
5 all 462,000 acres of young-growth timber located  
6 within the Tongass National Forest; and

7 (2) assess all age classes of timber inventoried  
8 for the purpose of refining inventory and growth  
9 data to properly forecast yields from stands and fu-  
10 ture economic manufacturing feasibility with respect  
11 to the timber inventoried.
