Subject: Full Committee Markup

On **Thursday, February 16, 2012, at 10:00 a.m. in 1324 Longworth House Office Building**, the Committee on Natural Resources will hold a markup on the following bills:

- **HR 1837**, To address certain water-related concerns on the San Joaquin River, and for other purposes. “*San Joaquin Valley Water Reliability Act*”
- **HR 4019**, To increase employment and educational opportunities in, and improve the economic stability of, counties containing Federal forest land, while also reducing the cost of managing such land, by providing such counties a dependable source of revenue from such land, and for other purposes. “*Federal Forest County Revenue, Schools, and Jobs Act of 2012*”
