

Brian Hallman is the Executive Director of the American Tunaboat Association, which represents the owners of all large U.S. flag purse seine fishing vessels. Prior to this, Mr. Hallman served as the Deputy Director of the Inter-American Tropical Tuna Commission, one of five Regional Fisheries Management Organizations responsible for the conservation and management of highly migratory species.

Mr. Hallman began his career in international fisheries management with the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, soon moving to the Department of State, where he eventually led a number of U.S. delegations in international fisheries negotiations.

Mr. Hallman has a B.A. in political science from the College of William and Mary, and an M.A. in international relations from the Johns Hopkins School of Advanced International Studies.
