

COMMITTEE ACTION

The Committee on Natural Resources met in open session on Tuesday, March 24, 2015, and reconvened on Wednesday, March 25, 2015, to consider the following bills:

H.R. 308 (Rep. Trent Franks), To prohibit gaming activities on certain Indian lands in Arizona until the expiration of certain gaming compacts. *"Keep the Promise Act of 2015"*

The Subcommittee on Indian, Insular and Alaska Native Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 308 by unanimous consent.

An Amendment offered by Mr. Grijalva (GRIJALVA_.024), was not adopted by a roll call vote of 10 yeas and 21 nays.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by voice vote.

H.R. 152 (Rep. Walter Jones), To direct the Secretary of the Interior to enter into an agreement to provide for management of the free-roaming wild horses in and around the Currituck National Wildlife Refuge. *"Corolla Wild Horses Protection Act"*

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 152 by unanimous consent.

Approved and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 373 (Rep. Joe Heck), To direct the Secretary of the Interior and Secretary of Agriculture to expedite access to certain Federal land under the administrative jurisdiction of each Secretary for good Samaritan search-and-recovery missions, and for other purposes. *"Good Samaritan Search and Recovery Act"*

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 373 by unanimous consent.

Approved and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 404 (Rep. Adrian Smith of NE), To authorize early repayment of obligations to the Bureau of Reclamation within the Northport Irrigation District in the State of Nebraska.

The Subcommittee on Water, Power and Oceans was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 404 by unanimous consent.

Approved and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 533 (Rep. Markwayne Mullin), To revoke the charter of incorporation of the Miami Tribe of Oklahoma at the request of that tribe, and for other purposes.

The Subcommittee on Indian, Insular and Alaska Native Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 533 by unanimous consent.

Approved and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 979 (Rep. Tom McClintock), To designate a mountain in the John Muir Wilderness of the Sierra National Forest as "Sky Point".

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 979 by unanimous consent.

Approved and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 984 (Rep. Jeff Fortenberry), To amend the National Trails System Act to direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study on the feasibility of designating the Chief Standing Bear National Historic Trail, and for other purposes.

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 984 by unanimous consent.

Approved and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 1168 (Rep. Kevin Cramer), To amend the Indian Child Protection and Family Violence Prevention Act to require background checks before foster care placements are ordered in tribal court proceedings, and for other purposes. "*Native American Children's Safety Act*"

The Subcommittee on Indian, Insular and Alaska Native Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1168 by unanimous consent.

Approved and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

H.R. 1324 (Rep. Jared Polis), To adjust the boundary of the Arapaho National Forest, Colorado, and for other purposes. "*Arapaho National Forest Boundary Adjustment Act of 2015*"

The Subcommittee on Federal Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1324 by unanimous consent.

Approved and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.
