

## **COMMITTEE MARKUP ACTION SUMMARY REPORT**

The Committee on Natural Resources met in open session on April 9, 2014, to consider the following bills:

**H.R. 503 (Roe)**, To authorize the National Desert Storm Memorial Association to establish the National Desert Storm and Desert Shield Memorial as a commemorative work in the District of Columbia, and for other purposes. *“National Desert Storm and Desert Shield War Memorial Act”*

The Subcommittee on Public Lands and Environmental Regulation was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 503 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Bishop of Utah Amendment #1, was AGREED TO by unanimous consent.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives, as amended, by unanimous consent.

**H.R. 863 (Maloney)**, To establish the Commission to Study the Potential Creation of a National Women's History Museum, and for other purposes. *“Commission to Study the Potential Creation of a National Women's History Museum Act of 2013”*

The Subcommittee on Public Lands and Environmental Regulation was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 863 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Bishop of Utah Amendment #1, was AGREED TO by unanimous consent.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives, as amended, by unanimous consent.

**H.R. 2208 (Wittman)**, To extend the authorization of appropriations for allocation to carry out approved wetlands conservation projects under the North American Wetlands Conservation Act through fiscal year 2017. *“North American Wetlands Conservation Extension Act of 2013”*

The Subcommittee on Fisheries, Wildlife, Oceans and Insular Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2208 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Hastings of Washington Amendment #1, was AGREED TO by voice vote.
- An amendment offered by Ms. Bordallo.001 to the Hastings of Washington Amendment #1, was NOT AGREED TO by a roll call vote of 14 yeas and 22 nays.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives, as amended, by voice vote.

**H.R. 2430 (Pascrell)**, To adjust the boundaries of Paterson Great Falls National Historical Park to include Hinchliffe Stadium, and for other purposes. *“Hinchliffe Stadium Heritage Act of 2013”*

The Subcommittee on Public Lands and Environmental Regulation was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 2430 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Bishop of Utah Amendment #1, was AGREED TO by unanimous consent.
- An amendment offered by Mr. Grijalva.020, was AGREED TO by unanimous consent.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives, as amended, by unanimous consent.

**H.R. 3802 (Lynch)**, To extend the legislative authority of the Adams Memorial Foundation to establish a commemorative work in honor of former President John Adams and his legacy, and for other purposes.

The Subcommittee on Public Lands and Environmental Regulation was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 3802 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Bishop of Utah Amendment #1, was AGREED TO by unanimous consent.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives, as amended, by unanimous consent.

**H.R. 4002 (Mullin)**, To revoke the charter of incorporation of the Miami Tribe of Oklahoma at the request of that tribe, and for other purposes.

The Subcommittee on Indian and Alaska Native Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4002 by unanimous consent.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

**H.R. 4017 (Heck)**, To designate a peak located in Nevada as "Mount Reagan".

The Subcommittee on Public Lands and Environmental Regulation was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4017 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. DeFazio.066, was NOT AGREED TO by voice vote.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

**H.R. 4120 (Hoyer)**, To amend the National Law Enforcement Museum Act to extend the termination date.

The Subcommittee on Public Lands and Environmental Regulation was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4120 by unanimous consent.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.

**H.R. 4253 (Bishop)**, To permanently withdraw, reserve, and transfer Bureau of Land Management lands used for military purposes in Alaska, Nevada, and New Mexico to the appropriate Secretary of the military department concerned. *“Bureau of Land Management Withdrawn Military Lands Efficiency and Savings Act”*

The Subcommittee on Public Lands and Environmental Regulation was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4253 by unanimous consent.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by a roll call vote of 21 yeas and 10 nays.

**H.R. 4309 (Bordallo)**, To amend the Sikes Act to make certain improvements to the administration of cooperative agreements for land management related to Department of Defense readiness activities, and for other purposes.

The Subcommittee on Fisheries, Wildlife, Oceans and Insular Affairs was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 4309 by unanimous consent.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Gosar.059 was AGREED TO by a roll call vote of 21 yeas and 14 nays.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives, as amended, by voice vote.
