The Board of Directors at the annual meeting reviews all compensation agreements and approves the rate of compensation for the following year for all employees and independent contractors, including the contract for the executive director and executive assistant. Rates are based on federal and state approved rates for the various positions.

Part VI, Line 19:

The organization makes its governing documents and financial statements available to the public by posting information on their website on how to contact the organization. Copies of documents and financial statements are sent to anyone requesting the information. Also copies are given to all state and federal grantors on an annual basis.
