Professor McGinley teaches courses administrative, environmental and natural resources law. McGinley served from 1972-1975 as Special Assistant Attorney General, Pennsylvania Environmental Strike Force and Counsel to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Office of Deep Mine Safety where he enforced the Commonwealth's environmental and coal mine safety laws. Professor McGinley was co-editor of the five-volume treatise "Coal Law & Regulation" and of the annual proceedings of the Eastern Mineral Law Foundation (now Energy and Mineral law Foundation) of which he was a founder. He also has served as chair of the American Bar Association-American Law Institute Course of Study: "Legal issues in the Coal Industry." He is admitted to practice law in Pennsylvania and West Virginia. Professor McGinley provided support for the Independent Investigation of the 2006 Sago Mine disaster and was a member of the Governor's Independent Investigation Panel that investigated the 2010 Massey Energy Upper Big Branch Mine Explosion. Professor McGinley has written and published scholarship relating to the Federal Surface Mining Control & Reclamation Act of 1977, The Federal Coal Mine Health & Safety Act, the Clean Water Act and Constitutional Takings Jurisprudence relating to natural resources.
