

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1904
OFFERED BY MR. BISHOP OF UTAH

(Page and line numbers refer to the introduced bill)

Page 3, line 8, strike “Riparian”.

Page 3, beginning line 24, strike paragraph (1) and insert the following:

1 (1) APACHE LEAP.—The term “Apache Leap”
2 means the approximately 807 acres of land depicted
3 on the map entitled “Southeast Arizona Land Ex-
4 change and Conservation Act of 2011–Apache Leap”
5 and dated March 2011.

Page 4, beginning line 18, strike paragraphs (5) and (6) and insert the following:

6 (5) OAK FLAT CAMPGROUND.—The term “Oak
7 Flat Campground” means the approximately 50
8 acres of land comprising approximately 16 developed
9 campsites depicted on the map entitled “Southeast
10 Arizona Land Exchange and Conservation Act of
11 2011–Oak Flat Campground” and dated March
12 2011.

13 (6) OAK FLAT WITHDRAWAL AREA.—The term
14 “Oak Flat Withdrawal Area” means the approxi-

1 mately 760 acres of land depicted on the map enti-
2 tled “Southeast Arizona Land Exchange and Con-
3 servation Act of 2011–Oak Flat Withdrawal Area”
4 and dated March 2011.

Page 6, line 20, insert before the period the fol-
lowing: “in compliance with the requirements of section
254.9 of title 36, Code of Federal Regulations”.

Page 11, line 19, insert before the semicolon the fol-
lowing: “and any environmental review document under
subsection (j)”.

Page 12, lines 8 and 9, strike “National Environ-
mental Policy (42 U.S.C. 3421 et seq.)” and insert “Na-
tional Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4321
et seq.)”.

Page 13, lines 17 and 22, and page 14, lines 3 and
14, insert “Exchange and” after “Land”.

Page 14, beginning line 21, strike subparagraphs
(A), (B), and (C) and insert the following:

5 (A) the approximately 3,050 acres of land
6 located in Pinal County, Arizona, identified as
7 “Lands to DOI” as generally depicted on the
8 map entitled “Southeast Arizona Land Ex-
9 change and Conservation Act of 2011–Non-

1 Federal Parcel—Lower San Pedro River” and
2 dated July 6, 2011;

3 (B) the approximately 160 acres of land
4 located in Gila and Pinal Counties, Arizona,
5 identified as “Lands to DOI” as generally de-
6 picted on the map entitled “Southeast Arizona
7 Land Exchange and Conservation Act of 2011—
8 Non-Federal Parcel—Dripping Springs” and
9 dated July 6, 2011; and

10 (C) the approximately 940 acres of land lo-
11 cated in Santa Cruz County, Arizona, identified
12 as “Lands to DOI” as generally depicted on the
13 map entitled “Southeast Arizona Land Ex-
14 change and Conservation Act of 2011—Non-
15 Federal Parcel—Appleton Ranch” and dated
16 July 6, 2011.

Page 16, line 11, strike “RIPARIAN”.

Page 16, lines 16, 17, and 24, strike “Riparian”.

Page 23, beginning line 3, strike subsection (b) and
insert the following:

17 (b) PAYMENT.—The Town shall pay to the Secretary
18 the market value for each parcel of land or interest in land

- 1 acquired under this section, as determined by appraisals
- 2 conducted in accordance with section 4(d).
