**Subject:** Legislative Hearing – May 17, 2012

On **Thursday, May 17, 2012 at 2:00 p.m. in room 1324 Longworth House Office Building**, the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests and Public Lands will hold a legislative hearing on the following bills:

- **HR 1103 (Sablan)**, To direct the Secretary of the Interior to develop, maintain, and administer an annex in Tinian, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, as an extension of the American Memorial Park located in Saipan, and for other purposes. “*American Memorial Park Tinian Annex Act*”
- **HR 3100 (Canseco)**, To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to expand the boundary of the San Antonio Missions National Historical Park, to conduct a study of potential land acquisitions, and for other purposes. “*San Antonio Missions National Historical Park Boundary Expansion Act*”
- **HR 3365 (Lummis)**, To reauthorize the Federal Land Transaction Facilitation Act, and for other purposes. “*Federal Land Transaction Facilitation Act Reauthorization of 2011*”
- **HR 4400 (Markey)**, To designate the Salt Pond Visitor Center at Cape Cod National Seashore as the “Thomas P. O’Neill, Jr. Salt Pond Visitor Center,” and for other purposes.
- **S 270 (Wyden)**, A bill to direct the Secretary of the Interior to convey certain Federal land to Deschutes County, Oregon. “*La Pine Land Conveyance Act*”
