At the 2009 Geothermal Research Council Conference he spoke on electricity markets for geothermal power. In Oct., 2010 his firm, Sextant Research, led a permitting/regulatory workshop in Sacramento attended by 17 agencies. Dr. Piszczalski has also worked for renewable-energy developers and utilities purchasing renewable power. His Engineering PhD. (1986) is from the University of Michigan. Dr. Piszczalski was also a professor in UM's Engineering & Business Schools.
