The Subcommittee on Public Lands and Environmental Regulation legislative hearing on the following bills:

- **H.R. ___** (Bishop), To amend the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act to improve consistency and accountability in the collection and expenditure of Federal recreation fees, and for other purposes.
- **H.R. 2743** (Ruiz), To make the National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass available at a discount to certain veterans. *“Veterans Eagle Parks Pass Act”*
- **H.R. 3976** (Nugent), To provide for a lifetime National Recreational Pass for any veteran with a service-connected disability, and for other purposes. *“Wounded Veterans Recreation Act”*
