**GEORGE TIGER, PRINCIPAL CHIEF
MUSCOGEE (CREEK) NATION**

George P. Tiger is the Principal Chief of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation. The Muscogee (Creek) Nation is the fourth largest of 586 federally recognized tribes in the United States and has an enrollment of 75,000 citizens. The tribe, as a sovereign Native nation, is fully self-governed and (the American government framework) is a tripartite government consisting of Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branches.

Chief Tiger was born at the rural family home near Henryetta, Oklahoma. He is the grandson of another Principal Chief, Motey Tiger, who served from 1907 until 1917 and his matrilineal descendancy renders him a member of the Hickory Ground Tribal Town and the Wind Clan. His religious affiliation is Baptist and a member of Yardeka Indian Baptist Church

Chief Tiger graduated from Morris (OK) High School and later attended Northeastern A&M Junior College, Haskell Indian Junior College and Northeastern State University. He is currently the President of the Board of Regents of Haskell Indian Nations University and has served on the Board for 22 years representing 19 Eastern Oklahoma Tribes.

Tiger recently was given an Honorary Doctorate degree In Human Letters from Bacone College in Muskogee, Okla.

Chief Tiger's Tribal government career began with the Seminole Nation in the 1970's. He has since held many positions in other tribes as well as the Muscogee Creek Nation. He served as a member of the Muscogee (Creek) National Council for a period of 14 years and as Speaker of the Council in 2006-2007. As mentioned, his family has a rich history of involvement in Muscogee Tribal government. His father was a resolution writer for the National Council in the late 1950's and early 1960's. His uncle George Harjo served on the first Advisory Council of the Muscogee Nation before a Constitution referendum allowed for election of Muscogee Nation leadership.

Tiger sits on countless boards and committees across the United States and Indian Country. He has been recognized for his advocacy and his leadership by being the past elected Chairman of United Indian Nations of Oklahoma and, more recently, President of the Five Civilized Tribes Intertribal Council.
