## Hastings Commends Decision Holding Interior Dept. Accountable on **Offshore Drilling Moratorium**

WASHINGTON D.C. - House Natural Resources Committee Chairman Doc Hastings (WA-04) released the following statement after Judge Martin Feldman yesterday found the Department of the Interior in contempt of court for continuing their moratorium on offshore drilling in the Gulf Coast.
