Vote Check: Republicans Vote Against Increasing Hunting Fees for the Federal Government to Buy More Private Land

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Today, the House Natural Resources Committee held a markup of the *Migratory Bird Treaty Act Penalty and Enforcement Act of 2009* (H.R. 1916), which increases the cost of the federal duck stamp (used as a hunting permit) from \$15 to \$25 in 2010 and mandates the federal government use all proceeds to acquire more private land.

"When the American people are suffering real economic pain with too many of our constituents having lost their jobs, their savings, and even their homes, we should not be considering legislation that simply fattens the federal coffers by raising prices on Americans in order for the government to purchase more private land," said Ranking Member Doc Hastings. "Republicans were successful in making some improvements to this bill, specifically by passing amendments to eliminate the price increase to \$35, protect citizens from land condemnation, and ensure hunting remains affordable for young adults, senior citizens, the disabled, military personal and veterans. Unfortunately, my Democrat colleagues voted against amendments that would have limited government acquisition of private land and allowed this money to be used for other beneficial purposes including operation and maintenance of current refuge land, payments to counties with refuge land, and hunting and fishing programs for the disabled."

VOTE CHECK

Rep. Hastings of Washington Amendment #36 – Setting \$100 Million Cap on Fish and Wildlife Land Acquisition

This amendment would keep the price of a duck stamp at the current \$15 level if in the prior year, the Fish and Wildlife Service had \$100 million to spend on land acquisition. This figure of \$100 million is calculated by totaling the funds appropriated in the land acquisition account, the North Americans Wetland Conservation Act account, and the prior year's duck stamp collections. If the federal government has \$100 million dollars to buy land for refuges, Congress shouldn't charge every duck hunter in America another \$10 a year in order to purchase more private land.

Hastings of Washington Amendment #27 - Dedicating at Least Half of Increase to Operations and Maintenance in National Wildlife Refuge System

The National Wildlife Refuge System currently has a \$2.6 billion operations-and-maintenance backlog with 3,348 "mission critical" projects pending completion. This amendment would require that at least <u>half</u> of the \$10 dollar increase be spent on operations-and-maintenance projects and that the Migratory Bird Conservation Commission would have the responsibility to decide if any of the additional 50 percent of the increased funds would be set aside for that purpose.
