

COMMITTEE ACTION

The Committee on Natural Resources met in an open markup session on Thursday, February 16, 2012, and considered the following bills:

HR 4019, To increase employment and educational opportunities in, and improve the economic stability of, counties containing Federal forest land, while also reducing the cost of managing such land, by providing such counties a dependable source of revenue from such land, and for other purposes. *“Federal Forest County Revenue, Schools, and Jobs Act of 2012”*

HR 1837, To address certain water-related concerns on the San Joaquin River, and for other purposes. *“San Joaquin Valley Water Reliability Act”*
