Subject: Full Committee Markup Notice

The Committee on Natural Resources has scheduled a markup beginning on **Tuesday**, **May 8**, **2018**, **at 10:15 a.m.** The Committee will consider the following bills:

- H.R. 221 (Rep. Don Young), To reauthorize the Hydrographic Services Improvement Act of 1998, and for other purposes. "Hydrographic Services Improvement Amendments Act";
- H.R. 1791 (Rep. David G. Reichert), To establish the Mountains to Sound Greenway National Heritage Area in the State of Washington, and for other purposes. "Mountains to Sound Greenway National Heritage Act";
- H.R. 2591 (Rep. Austin Scott), To amend the Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration Act to modernize the funding of wildlife conservation, and for other purposes. "Modernizing the Pittman-Robertson Fund for Tomorrow's Needs Act of 2017";
- H.R. 3535 (Rep. Doug LaMalfa), To restore Federal recognition to the Ruffey Rancheria of California, and for other purposes. "Ruffey Rancheria Restoration Act of 2017"; Amendments to H.R. 3535 must be drafted to the amendment in the nature of a substitute, attached to this notice.
- H.R. 4032 (Rep. Tom O'Halleran), To confirm undocumented Federal rights-of-way or easements on the Gila River Indian Reservation, clarify the northern boundary of the Gila River Indian Community's Reservation, to take certain land located in Maricopa County and Pinal County, Arizona, into trust for the benefit of the Gila River Indian Community, and for other purposes. "Gila River Indian Community Federal Rights-of-Way, Easements and Boundary Clarification Act";
- H.R. 4506 (Rep. Norma J. Torres), To provide incentives to encourage tribal job creation and economic activity, and for other purposes. "Jobs for Tribes Act";
- **H.R. 4689 (Rep. Adrian Smith),** To authorize early repayment of obligations to the Bureau of Reclamation within the Northport Irrigation District in the State of Nebraska;

- H.R. 5655 (Rep. Andy Barr), To establish the Camp Nelson Heritage National Monument in the State of Kentucky as a unit of the National Park System, and for other purposes. "Camp Nelson Heritage National Monument Act".
