Subject: Full Committee Markup

On Wednesday, May 16, 2012, at 10:00 a.m. in 1324 Longworth House Office Building, the Committee on Natural Resources will hold a markup on the following bills:

- **HR 1192**, To extend the current royalty rate for soda ash. "Soda Ash Royalty Extension, Job Creation, and Export Enhancement Act of 2011"
- **HR 3973**, To facilitate the development of energy on Indian lands by reducing Federal regulations that impede tribal development of Indian lands, and for other purposes. "*Native American Energy Act*"
- HR 4043, To amend title 10, United States Code, to direct the Secretary of Defense to establish Southern Sea Otter Military Readiness Areas for national defense purposes, and for other purposes. *"Military Readiness and Southern Sea Otter Conservation Act"*
- **HR 4381**, To direct the Secretary of the Interior to establish goals for an all-of-the-above energy production plan strategy on a 4-year basis on all onshore Federal lands managed by the Department of the Interior and the Forest Service. "*Planning for American Energy Act of 2012*"
- **HR 4382**, To ensure Federal oil and natural gas lease sales occur, eliminate redundant leasing bureaucracy, and provide leasing certainty. "*Providing Leasing Certainty for American Energy Act of 2012*"
- **HR 4383**, To streamline the application for permits to drill process and increase funds for energy project permit processing, and for other purposes. *"Streamlining Permitting of American Energy Act of 2012"*
- **HR 4402**, To require the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary of Agriculture to more efficiently develop domestic sources of the minerals and mineral materials of strategic and critical importance to United States economic and national security and manufacturing competitiveness. "*National Strategic and Critical Minerals Production Act of 2012*"
