Subject: Full Committee Hearing in Grand Junction, Colorado, on June 1, 2018

On Friday, June 1, 2018, at 2:00 p.m. (MDT) the House Committee on Natural Resources will hold an oversight hearing entitled “*Examining the Natural Gas and Oil Shale Opportunities in Western Colorado.*”

The hearing will examine opportunities for the export of natural gas from the Piceance Basin through the proposed Jordan Cove LNG Terminal in Coos Bay Oregon. In addition, the hearing will evaluate the potential to develop domestic oil shale resources. This hearing will be held at Colorado Mesa University, room 213, 1100 North Ave, Grand Junction, CO 81501. Witnesses will be by invitation only.
