

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 788
OFFERED BY MS. BORDALLO OF GUAM

At the end of section 4 add the following:

1 (d) EQUIVALENT MINIMUM APPORTIONMENT AMONG
2 STATES AND TERRITORIES OF TAX REVENUES ACCRUING
3 TO FUND.—The first subsection (c) of section 4 of the
4 Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration Act (16 U.S.C.
5 669e), relating to apportionment of certain revenues ac-
6 cruing to the fund, is amended by striking “among the
7 States” and all that follows through the end of the first
8 sentence and inserting : “among the States and each of
9 Guam, the Virgin Islands, American Samoa, Puerto Rico,
10 and the Northern Mariana Islands in proportion to the
11 ratio that the population of each State and each such ter-
12 ritory bears to the population of all the States and such
13 territories: *Provided*, That each State shall be apportioned
14 not more than 3 percent of such revenues, and each State
15 and each such territory shall be apportioned not less than
16 1 percent of such revenues.”.
