

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE  
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3764  
OFFERED BY MR. GRAVES**

Page 78, line 8, strike “Section” and insert “(a) Section”.

Page 78, after line 24, insert the following:

1       (b) GAO STUDY AND REPORT.—

2               (1) STUDY.—The Comptroller General of the  
3       United States shall conduct a study on the implica-  
4       tions of the amendments made by subsection (a), in-  
5       cluding the economic impact of expanding the defini-  
6       tion of term “undeveloped coastal barrier” under the  
7       Coastal Barrier Resources Act to private property,  
8       any restriction on or limitation of private property  
9       rights, and any impacts of such amendments on per-  
10      forming activities such as coastal restoration, coast-  
11      line renourishment, and maintenance for naviga-  
12      tional purposes.

13              (2) REPORT.—Not later than 90 days after the  
14      date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller Gen-  
15      eral of the United States shall transmit a report on  
16      the findings of the study required under paragraph

1 (1) to the Committee on Natural Resources of the  
2 House of Representatives and the Committee on En-  
3 ergy and Natural Resources of the Senate.

4 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE AND FURTHER CONGRES-  
5 SIONAL ACTION.—The amendments made by subsection  
6 (a) shall not take effect until—

7 (1) the report required under subsection (b)(2)  
8 is received by the committees described in such sub-  
9 section; and

10 (2) further legislation is enacted to affirm that  
11 such amendments shall take effect.
