A BILL

To exempt importation and exportation of sea urchins and sea cucumbers from licensing requirements under the Endangered Species Act of 1973.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION OF IMPORTATION AND EXPOR-**
4 **TATION OF SEA URCHINS AND SEA CUCUM-**
5 **BERS FROM LICENSING REQUIREMENT.**

6 (a) EXEMPTION.—Notwithstanding section 9(d)(1) of
7 the Endangered Species Act of 1973 (16 U.S.C.
8 1538(d)(1)) and section 14.91 of title 50, Code of Federal

1 Regulations, any person may engage in business as an im-
2 porter or exporter of fish or wildlife described in sub-
3 section (b) of this section without procuring an import/
4 export license under such section of that Act or subpart
5 I of part 14 of such title.

6 (b) COVERED FISH OR WILDLIFE.—The fish or wild-
7 life referred to in subsection (a) are members of the phy-
8 lum Echinodermata that are commonly known as sea ur-
9 chins and sea cucumbers, including products thereof,
10 that—

11 (1) do not require a permit under part 16, 17,
12 or 23 of title 50, Code of Federal Regulations; and

13 (2) are—

14 (A) imported or exported for purposes of
15 human or animal consumption; or

16 (B) taken in waters under the jurisdiction
17 of the United States or on the high seas for
18 recreational purposes.
