Availability of funds 15 "(a) IN GENERAL.—Amounts deposited in the Fund 16 17 under section 200302 shall be made available for expenditure, without further appropriation or fiscal year limita-18 tion, to carry out the purposes of the Fund (including ac-19

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counts and programs made available from the Fund under
 the Consolidated and Further Continuing Appropriations
 Act, 2015 (Public Law 113–235)).

4 "(b) ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS.—Amounts made avail5 able under subsection (a) shall be in addition to amounts
6 made available to the Fund under section 105 of the Gulf
7 of Mexico Energy Security Act of 2006 (43 U.S.C. 1331
8 note; Public Law 109–432) or otherwise appropriated
9 from the Fund.

- "(1) SUBMISSION OF COST ESTIMATES.—The
  President shall submit to Congress detailed account,
  program, and project allocations to be funded under
  subsection (a) as part of the annual budget submission of the President.

 following:

5 the annual authorized funding amount shall be made
6 available each year for projects that secure recreational
7 public access to existing Federal public land for hunting,
8 fishing, or other recreational purposes.".

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
