1 SEC. ____. PROHIBITION ON LEASING OFFSHORE NEW JER 2 SEY.

3 (a) **PROHIBITION**.—Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior shall not 4 5 make available for leasing under this Act or pursuant to 6 the Proposed Final Outer Continental Shelf Oil & Gas 7 Leasing Program (2012–2017) any area of the outer Continental Shelf within the offshore administrative bound-8 9 aries of the State of New Jersev, if the Governor of New Jersey certifies to the Secretary that the voters of that 10 11 State disapproved lease sales for the period of that program for that area in a referendum conducted in accord-12 13 ance with the laws of the State.

(b) LIMITATION ON CERTIFICATION AND REFERENDUM.—A certification and referendum referred to in
subsection (a) shall apply only for purposes of this section.
(c) OFFSHORE ADMINISTRATIVE BOUNDARIES DEFINED.—In this section the term "offshore administrative
boundaries" means the boundaries depicted with respect
to New Jersey on the Bureau of Ocean Energy, Manage-
