Last August, the Obama Administration implemented the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service's (FWS) final rule on "Non-Subsistence Take of Wildlife, and Public Participation and Closure Procedures, on National Wildlife Refuges in Alaska." Res. 69 would undo this final rule that boldly preempts the authority of the Alaska Department of Fish and Game to manage wildlife for both recreational and subsistence hunting on NWRs in Alaska. The sustainable management of these natural resources needs to be led by the State working in cooperation with the FWS. The FWS final rule would set an ill-advised national precedent that could have far reaching negative implications on the lower 48 states. H.J. Res. 69 will restore the jurisdictional state-federal relationship as Congress has previously directed.
