

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3824**OFFERED BY MR. CARDOZA OF CALIFORNIA**

Page 55, line 1, strike "90" and insert "180".

Page 55, at line 18 strike the close quotation marks and following period, and after line 18 insert the following:

1 “(9) Any determination of compliance under this sub-
2 section shall remain effective—

3 “(A) in the case of a written determination pro-
4 vided under paragraph (5)(A), for the 10-year period
5 beginning on the date the written determination is
6 provided; or

7 “(B) in the case of a determination that under
8 paragraph (6) the Secretary is deemed to have
9 made, the 5-year period beginning on the first date
10 the Secretary is deemed to have made the deter-
11 mination.

12 “(10) The Secretary may withdraw a determination
13 of compliance under this section only if the Secretary de-
14 termines that, because of unforeseen changed cir-
15 cumstances, the continuation of the use to which the de-
16 termination applies would preclude conservation measures



1 essential to the survival of any endangered species or
2 threatened species. Such a withdrawal shall take effect 10
3 days after the date the Secretary provides notice of the
4 withdrawal to the requester.

5 “(11) The Secretary may extend the period that ap-
6 plies under paragraph (5) by up to 180 days if seasonal
7 considerations make a determination impossible within the
8 period that would otherwise apply.”.
