## COMMITTEE ACTION

The Committee on Resources met in open markup session on Wednesday, November 5, 2003, and considered the following bills:

**H.R. 521** (Doyle), To establish the Steel Industry National Historic Site in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. (Steel Industry National Historic Site Act)

By unanimous consent, the Subcommittee on National Parks, Recreation, and Public Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 521.

Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute offered by Mr. Pombo, was agreed to by unanimous consent.

Ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, by unanimous consent.

**H.R. 1798** (Johnson), To establish the Upper Housatonic Valley National Heritage Area in the State of Connecticut and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and for other purposes. (Upper Housatonic Valley National Heritage Area Act)

Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute offered by Mr. Radanovich, was agreed to by unanimous consent.

Ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, by unanimous consent.

**H.R. 2693** (Gilchrest), To reauthorize the Marine Mammal Protection Act of 1972, an for other purposes. (Marine Mammal Protection Act Amendments of 2003)

The following amendments were offered:

An Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute offered by Mr. Gilchrest, was agreed to by voice vote.

An Amendment offered by Mr. Inslee to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute by Mr. Gilchrest, was withdrawn.

An Amendment offered by Mr. Young to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute by Mr. Gilchrest, was withdrawn.
