COMMITTEE ACTION

The Committee on Resources met in open markup session on Tuesday, July 15, 2003, and considered the following bills:

H.R. 1006 (McKeon), To amend the Lacey Act Amendments of 1981 to further the conservation of certain wildlife species. (Captive Wildlife Safety Act)

By unanimous consent, the Subcommittee on Fisheries Conservation, Wildlife, and Oceans was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 1006.

The following amendment was offered:

An Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute was offered by Mr. Gilchrest, was passed by voice vote.

Ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, by voice vote

H.R.1409 (C. Taylor), To provide for a Federal land exchange for the environmental, educational, and cultural benefit of the American public and the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, and for other purposes. (Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Land Exchange Act of 2002)

Ordered favorably reported to the House, without amendment, by voice vote.

S. 111 (Sen. Campbell), A bill to direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a special resource study to determine the national significance of the Miami Circle site in the State of Florida as well as the suitability and feasibility of its inclusion in the National Park System as part of Biscayne National Park, and for other purposes.

By unanimous consent, the Subcommittee on National Parks, Recreation and Public Lands was discharged from further consideration of S. 111.

Ordered favorably reported to the House, by voice vote.
