Subcommittee on Fisheries Conservation, Wildlife & Oceans June 3, 2004

The Subcommittee on Fisheries Conservation, Wildlife and Oceans, met in open markup session on Thursday, June 3, 2004, and considered the following bills:

S. 1814 (Sen. Kit Bond) - A bill to transfer federal lands between the Secretary of Agriculture and the Secretary of the Interior.

Forwarded to Full Committee by unanimous consent.

H.R. 3479 (Madeleine Bordallo) - A bill to provide for the control and eradication of the brown tree snake on the island of Guam and the prevention of the introduction of the brown tree snake to other areas of the United States, and for other purposes.

Forwarded to Full Committee by unanimous consent.

H.R. 4027 (Ileana Ros-Lehtinen) - A bill to authorize the Secretary of Commerce to make available to the University of Miami property under the administrative jurisdiction of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration on Virginia Key, Florida, for use by the University for a Marine Life Science Center.

Amendment in the Nature of the Substitute, offered by Mr. Gilchrest, was agreed to by unanimous consent.

Forwarded to Full Committee, as amended, by unanimous consent.
