5	(a) APPROVAL REQUIRED.—The Secretary of the In-
6	terior and the Secretary of Commerce shall not restrict
7	recreational or commercial fishing access to any State or
8	territorial marine waters or Great Lakes waters within the
9	jurisdiction of the National Park Service or the Office of
10	National Marine Sanctuaries, respectively, unless those re-
11	strictions are developed in coordination with, and ap-
12	proved by, the fish and wildlife management agency of the
13	State or territory that has fisheries management authority
14	over those waters.
15	(b) Definition.—In this section, the term "marine
16	waters' includes coastal waters and estuaries.
