

EN BLOC AMENDMENTS TO H.R. 3210
OFFERED BY MR. FLEMING OF LOUISIANA

Beginning at page 5, strike line 17 and all that follows through page 6, line 10, and insert the following:

1 (c) APPLICATION OF CIVIL FORFEITURE LAWS.—
2 Section 5(d) of such Act (16 U.S.C. 3374(d)) is amend-
3 ed—

4 (1) by inserting “(1)” before “Civil”;

5 (2) by inserting “, except as provided in para-
6 graphs (2) and (3) of this subsection” before the pe-
7 riod at the end; and

8 (3) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(2) Subsection (d)(4) of section 983 of such chapter,
10 and the second sentence of subsection (a)(1)(F) of such
11 section, shall not apply to plants or plant products.

12 “(3) This section is the sole authority for civil seizure
13 or forfeiture actions alleging, or predicated upon, a viola-
14 tion of section 3.”.

Beginning at page 6, line 11, strike section 4 and insert the following:

1 **SEC. 4. LIMITATION ON APPLICATION OF FOREIGN LAWS.**

2 (a) PROHIBITED ACTS.—Section 3(a) of such Act (16
3 U.S.C. 3372(a)) is amended—

4 (1) in paragraph (2)(B), in clause (ii) and in
5 clause (iii), by striking “foreign law” and inserting
6 “foreign law that is directed at the protection, con-
7 servation, and management of plants”; and

8 (2) in paragraph (3)(B), in clause (ii) and in
9 clause (iii), by striking “foreign law” and inserting
10 “foreign law that is directed at the protection, con-
11 servation, and management of plants”.

12 (b) CIVIL PENALTIES.—Section 4(a)(1) of such Act
13 (16 U.S.C. 3373(a)(1)) is amended by striking “foreign
14 law” and inserting “foreign law that is directed at the pro-
15 tection, conservation, and management of plants”.

Beginning at page 8, line 15, strike sections 6, 7,
and 8.
