  - We represented two entities in suing the government in *Free Enterprise Fund v. Public Company Accounting Oversight Board*, 130 S.Ct. 3138 (2010). We were not ourselves a plaintiff, but helped represent those who were. The case was brought in February 2006 (*see Free Enterprise Fund v. Pub. Co. Accounting Oversight Bd.*, D.D.C. Case No. 06-0217), and reached the Supreme Court in 2010. (The PCAOB is nominally a non-profit corporation, but the government did not contest our claim that it was part of the government for purposes of constitutional strictures, and accordingly, the Supreme Court found its tenure protections violated separation of powers principles in the constitution that limit the prerogatives of government officials).
  - We are currently suing the government on our own behalf in two closely-related cases. . (1) Competitive Enterprise Institute, Freedom Works, and the Science and Environmental Policy Project v. Environmental Protection Agency, D.C. Cir. No. 10-1045 (docketed Feb. 16, 2010). This case has been consolidated with a lead case filed by someone else. See Coalition for Responsible Regulation v. E.P.A., No. 09-1322. (2) Competitive Enterprise Institute, Freedom Works, and the Science and

Environmental Policy Project v. Environmental Protection Agency and National Highway Transportation Safety Administration, D.C. Cir. Case No. 10-1143 (docketed June 29, 2010). This case has been consolidated with a lead case filed by someone else. See Coalition for Responsible Regulation v. E.P.A., No. 10-1092.
